## Day 1: Reach Leh by Air

Reach Leh by Air & first day is to rest for acclimatization. Evening scroll the markets of Leh. Overnight stay in Hotel, followed by dinner.

#### Day 2: Leh Local

Today, wake up easy in the morning, we will visit Magnetic Road, Sangam, Gurudwara Pather Sahib, Hall of Fame, Spituk Monastery, Magnetic Hills & Shanti Stupa, evening for shopping in Leh. Overnight stay in Hotel followed by Dinner.

# Day 3: Leh - Khardungla - Nubra

Move early in the morning for Khardung La to ensure that we reaches Khardung La without encountering lot of traffic. Once we reach the summit, you can take time out to get your photo taken next to the signboard which says "Khardung La, 18380 ft. (5602 m), Highest Motorable Road in the world". After that leave for Hunder 86 kms down the road from Khardung La pass. Hunder is set amidst fields of rye and barley and surrounded by fruit orchids and sand dunes. Enjoy Camel Ride & evening at leisure. Overnight stay at Hunder/Diskit followed by dinner.

# Day 4: Nubra - Turtuk - Nubra

After breakfast drive to Turtuk (which was first time opened for the tourist in 2010) which is a place Annexed by India only after the 1971 war, the village of Turtuk is one of the only Balti villages in India and lies right next to the LOC. The village with the whole population of muslims still resembles mini Pakistan. The village's inhabitants still use traditional utensils which are crafted from stone. Explore the village of Turtuk the village offers views of beautiful valley. On clear days you can have glimpse of K2 mountain peak located across the border in Pakistan. Return to Nubra by evening. Overnight stay in Nubra

## Day 5: Nubra - Shok Valley - Pangong Lake

Leave early in the morning for Pangong Tso Lake, Breakfast on the way to Pangong

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Lake (4350m, 14270ft), through Shok Valley, one of the least traveled route and most remote area of ladakh region. Arrive Pangong, which is the highest salt water Lake in the World, shared by two countries India & China. Enjoy the beauty of the lake. The lake is 5 km wide at its broadest point. All together it covers 604 km. During winter the lake freezes completely, despite being saline water. Overnight in camps with dinner.

## Day 6: Pangong Lake - Changang La Pass - Leh

Wake up early in the morning to enjoy the morning breathtaking views of the lake. Spend some time at the Lake & now after Breakfast move back to Leh, en route Changla Pass (5288m, 17350ft), it is the third highest motorable road in the world. Visit Thicksey & 3 Idiots school before reaching Leh. Check in to the hotel. Evening at your leisure. Overnight stay in hotel.

# Day 7: Leh Airport

Private transfer from Hotel to Airport. Take you flight. Tour Ends!!
